SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 8 We'll assemble at exclusive Hyatt Regency Lost Pines Resort near Bastrop, Texas. It's easily reached from I-35 and I-71. We can safely leave tow rigs for the week. If you're flying in, we'll pick you up at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport anytime after Friday noon.

We're invited to be honored guests at SVRA's Vintage National Championship race weekend at nearby Circuit of the Americas on Saturday and Sunday. Jean has booked rooms for Friday and Saturday nights, if you'd like to arrive early to attend SVRA at COTA. Call her asap. Sunday dinner/overnight at Lost Pines.

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 9 We'll rally South on twisting roads we've never driven before through a lovely area of prosperous ranches to the charming town of Rockport, on the Gulf of Mexico. 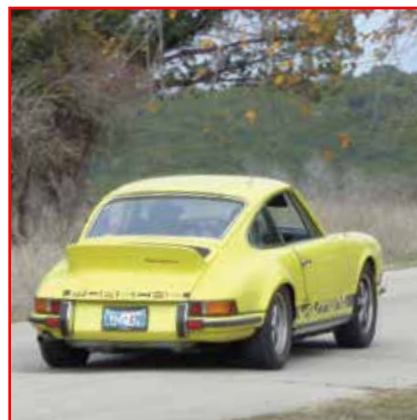
